

## **Dear Learning Pathways Families,**

As we are still considered "essential" by the County and State, Learning Pathways will be open for the remainder of this week to those parents that require childcare. The overwhelming majority of our parents have elected to "Shelter at home" as requested by the County and State government. We will be closed for the deep cleaning, and for our previously scheduled Spring break, from March 30 to April 10, but we are still intending to re-open on Monday, April 13.

We are currently working with our I.T. man in the development of a remote classroom set-up in which children will have a 3-hour window during the school day, 9AM-Noon, to access ongoing classroom activities and instruction. For those parents who wish to maintain a connection with Learning Pathways but do not feel confident that this is the best time to have their child attend school in a live classroom, the remote set-up will be available to them. Parents will receive detailed instructions and an on-line link that will take them directly to their child's classroom. The link will go live Monday, April 13. Boxes of classroom supplies and curriculum are currently being assembled for our at-home students and will be available for pick-up from your school by Wednesday, April 8. Educational videos will also continue to be uploaded to the Learning Pathways Preschool and Kindergarten YouTube page.

For those parents with older elementary school age children, we have been authorized by Community Care Licensing of the State of California to allow children as old as 12 years of age to be enrolled in our school until the Public schools re-open. Most of the elementary schools have provided material to their students for at-home schooling but, if needed, we will supply the proper curriculum to your older child for the duration of their attendance with us. We are temporarily converting our Music and Movement room into a classroom for those children ages 6-12. These older children will receive the same well-rounded quality educational experience that every child receives at Learning Pathways. The tuition for elementary school age children has yet to be determined, but it will be very reasonable. If you plan on taking advantage of this offer, please email us before April 13.

Thank you all for being so wonderful and generous during this strange, unprecedented time. We appreciate your patience and understanding. Without you, Learning Pathways would cease to exist.
